

## Test Your Speaking & Listening Skills

### Ask Personal Questions – Worksheet 2

- a) *Print the 4 female profile pages, 4 male profile pages, and the question sheet.*
- b) *Give one profile to each student, or share the profiles evenly if there are more or less than 8 people in the group.*
- c) *Using the suggested questions on the question sheet to help them, students ask each other questions about the person on their profile, in order to answer the questions below. They should not read each other's profile pages!*
- d) **Extension activity 1:** *students devise short role plays using the characters from the profiles and exploring them within a given situation, e.g. "You're in a bus shelter, the bus is 10 minutes late, it's raining and someone starts smoking..." etc.*
- e) **Extension activity 2:** *let students spend time in groups reading the information about the 8 different people, then take away the information and ask them the questions below in a team memory quiz.*
